The Syrian Arab Republic has implemented all its obligations under the process of its accession to the Convention and has fully cooperated with the Technical Secretariat of the OPCW and its teams providing all the facilitation required for the success of its tasks. During the period from November 2023 to November 2024, four rounds of consultations were held between the experts of the Syrian National Authority and the Declarations Assessment Team, where in addition to all the required cooperation Syria has provided documents, explanations and information on many issues. Therefore, we welcome and commend Syria's cooperation with the OPCW and trust in the continuation of the ongoing cooperation between both parties.
