NOTE BY THE DIRECTOR-GENERAL

DAY OF REMEMBRANCE FOR ALL VICTIMS OF CHEMICAL WARFARE

1. The Conference of the States Parties (the Conference) at its Twentieth Session decided that the Day of Remembrance for All Victims of Chemical Warfare would be observed in accordance with its decision C-20/DEC.10 (dated 3 December 2015).
2. The Chairperson of the Conference will preside over the Ceremony. The day will be observed with a moment of silence during the Twenty-Ninth Session of the Conference on 27 November 2024 in the King Willem-Alexander Theater of the World Forum.
3. This annual observance serves as a poignant reminder of the tragic human cost associated with chemical weapons. It is not only a solemn tribute to the countless lives lost and affected by these inhumane weapons, but also a powerful call to the international community to reinforce its commitment to the Chemical Weapons Convention. By commemorating this day, we honour the resilience and courage of survivors and reiterate our collective resolve to prevent the recurrence of such atrocities. The Technical Secretariat has developed a social media kit for stakeholders to raise the visibility of the Day of Remembrance. The kit contains ready-made graphics and suggested social media messages that can be used on stakeholders' own social media channels.
